

NYC Burial Assistance

Anyone who is seeking burial assistance must go to the city's burial claims unit in person with any documentation they have regarding the death of their loved one. It is a reimbursement service, so people should go after making funeral arrangements. Usually they need a receipt from a funeral home or other burial agency, but the only requirement is that the person who died or the mother of a stillborn was a New York City resident and files the request within 60 days of the death and the city will pay up to \$900 for a funeral service that costs no more than \$1,700.
